Re: Northern Gateway Pipelines Project - Hearing Order OH-4-2011

On behalf of Gitxaala Nation, we write to advise the Joint Review Panel that we do not expect to take the 12 hours originally estimated for our cross-examination of the Aboriginal Engagement & Public Consultation Panel. We estimate that our cross-examination of this panel will be in the range of two to three hours.

Please also be advised that counsel for Enoch Cree Nation, Ermineskin Cree Nation and Samson Cree Nation as well as Ms. Wier have kindly agreed to switch order with Gitxaala Nation to accommodate my schedule next week. As noted in Ms. Wier's letter of March 7, 2013, she had previously switched order with Douglas Channel Watch.
