Re: Consultations with Generation PGM Inc. on the Potential Draft Federal Environmental Assessment (EA) Conditions for the Marathon Palladium Project (Ref No. 54755)

To Whom It May Concern,

Generation PGM Inc. (GenPGM) has consulted Biigtigong Nishnaabeg on the contents of GenPGM's submissions regarding the potential draft federal environmental assessment conditions for the Marathon Palladium Project. Biigtigong Nishnaabeg accepts that the recommendations of GenPGM with respect to the timing of actions and deliverables advanced by GenPGM in their proposed changes to the conditions, in particular, as set out in conditions 5.2, 5.3, and 6.4.3, would be protective of Biigtigong Nishnaabeg's interests in its unceded, unsurrendered and exclusive Aboriginal Title territory. Biigtigong Nishnaabeg also confirms its comfort with the revised comments on condition 6.4, recently submitted by GenPGM, wherein GenPGM commits to the development of the air quality follow-up program as soon as possible, and in any event not later than 3 months following the commencement of construction.
