Nov 26 2013. We have a couple of visiting hunters on the farm this week. So far they have seen over 25 mule deer, a handful of whitetail deer, 3 or 4 moose, a couple of the coyote pack and most spectacular a herd of, get this, 58 Elk!! Right here on the farm along the banks and the entire elk herd, swam the river this AM, the climbed out at the Site of the Historic McKenzie Fort on the South side of the River from us. This herd of Elk are relatively new arrivals to this, "Serengetti" we seem to live on. They have been chased up the valley from the North and over here from the WILDLIFE PRESERVE directly across the river from the 2nd 1/4 section of our farm. This is due to hunting, Hydro research, and other human based disturbances from build and Oil and Gas exploration on their former habitats. As well it is reported that there are 12+ wolves just up the valley from our farm, and a further 18+ wolf pack just across the river around the proposed Damsite. Where will all this wildlife go when their habitat, is flooded and sloughed in? To town, what is their "Well we'll mitigate that when the time comes." Defense lawyer? Do we just shoot 25 deer, almost 60 elk, and 30 wolves? What is to be their outcome?
