Some of my concerns are about the end of the mine life and the 40 or more years after which Taseko has noted. There is no information on who looks after the ongoing lake re-circulation after the mine life expires. Further Taseko does not specifically address the "left over" processing liquids which contain hazardous and toxic chemicals. It seems the chemicals and residues stay there in some form. There is no information on how much of the processing chemicals will be used over the mine life and considering that extracting gold and copper involves dangerous chemicals, this should be available.
