I am submitting my concerns about the proposed building of LNG facility by Petronas for Lelu Island and Flora Bank critical wild salmon habitat in the Skeena River estuary. As is written, in the Constitution, Section 25, my Aboriginal Right to salmon will be in jeopardy. As the salmon are already suffering a downturn in population due to oil spills where the salmon migrate. Also the excess Carbon dioxide released by such a project would increase British Columbia's greenhouse gas emissions by 8.5%, which would make it almost impossible for BC to hit its climate change targets, and would contradict Canada's recent international climate change commitments.
