Why does Woodfibre LNG need a second floatel?

- › Now more than ever, Canada needs to diversify its energy markets. Woodfibre LNG is doing its part by advancing an application to bring a second floating workforce accommodation, or “floatel”, to site.
- › A second floatel would allow more workers on site and help us complete construction more quickly. Up to 900 new jobs would be created now, when they are needed most, by adding a second floatel.
- › Completing construction of the Woodfibre LNG project more quickly will bring more Canadian LNG to market sooner, create construction jobs immediately and bring economic benefits to Squamish, British Columbia and Canada.
- › The first floatel, the MV Isabelle X, has been a tremendous success and provides proof that the floatel accommodation model works well. The floatel has:
 - › Avoided additional pressure on the local housing market,
 - › Avoided additional highway and local traffic as all non-local workers are brought to site via ferry,
 - › Avoided any significant impact to local health services, with only 11 incidents requiring the services of the Squamish Hospital,
 - › Received positive feedback from the construction workforce with 71% agreeing that the floatel provides a high quality experience compared to other camp environments.

Will the second floatel be the same as the first?

- › The second floatel would be a vessel of similar size to the MV Isabelle X, accommodating roughly 650 workers.
- › It would also have many of the same amenities, including:
 - › Private rooms with dedicated ensuite bathrooms
 - › Onboard recreation facilities
 - › A fitness centre
 - › Top quality dining facilities
 - › Medical facilities and services
 - › Meeting, conference and office spaces
- › The second floatel would meet the same standards and commitments of the first, including a strict Worker Code of Conduct, mandatory Cultural and Gender Safety training and a commitment that workers will have no access to Squamish except for emergency circumstances.

Where are you getting the second floatel from?

Woodfibre LNG will procure the second floatel from Bridgemans, the same Vancouver-based, Canadian company that supplied the MV Isabelle X. Bridgemans will refit the second floatel as well as operate it as a subcontractor of McDermott, our EPC contractor.
