Subject: CN Milton Logistics Hub Project – Proposed Amendments to the Decision Statement – DFO Comments

As requested, the Fish and Fish Habitat Protection Program (the Program) of Fisheries and Oceans Canada (DFO) is providing comments on the proposed amendments to the Milton Logistics Hub Project Decision Statement regarding the proposed revision by Canadian National Railway Company (CN) on the reconfiguration of two existing oil pipelines around the terminal area.

DFO has reviewed the *Draft Analysis Report* prepared by Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) and supports the conclusion stated by IAAC that "*The Agency is of the view that no modifications to the mitigation measures and follow-up requirements included as conditions in the Decision Statement are necessary."* Further, DFO agrees that the proposed reconfiguration of the two existing oil pipelines will not result in potential adverse effects of fish and fish habitat that would be greater under this optimized approach because no fish or fish habitat would be located within the affected areas and no watercourse crossings would be required. DFO has no further comments.
