Hello, I am (Craig Tarbox) and writing in response to the revised Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), for the proposed Beaver Dam Mine Project. It would be a shame for it to be at risk especially when the benefits to all of Nova Scotia (and those involved from a far) is simply minimal.
