RE: CanWhite Sands Corp response to IAAC letter of clarification Received Sept 21, 2021 – *Explain your views on whether the Project should be designated under the IAA*

CanWhite Sands Corporation (CWS) submitted a response on October 15, 2021 to the IAAC letter received September 21, 2021.

Within the letter to CWS a question was asked “*Explain your views on whether the Project should be designated under the IAA*”. Upon further review of the timing and contents of the request received by IAAC on September 8, 2021 we provide the following information as to why a designation should not be recommended at this time.

Currently Manitoba Conservation and Climate, Environmental Approvals Branch are undergoing their review of the CanWhite’s Environment Act Proposal Extraction Project. The provincial review process includes the review of the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and a public review period which has just recently concluded. Circumventing the provincial government, its process, departments, jurisdiction and defined rights on this matter would not benefit the outcome at this time.

We believe the current process should be respected and that the application for designation should be based on the outcomes, findings, and recommendations of the current review process by Manitoba Conservation and Climate, Environmental Approvals Branch.

The applicants request of Designation is an attempt to circumvent this process including the reports and materials associated with this review.

At a minimum, the IAAC should review the questions, comments and answers submitted to Manitoba Conservation and Climate, Environmental Approvals public registry 6119 to have a full information package.

As at the date of this letter, CWS has just received the submitted questions and comments under the public registry 6119 to comment on. Responses will be prepared and presented to Manitoba Conservation and Climate, Environmental Approvals Branch as required.
