Hi Jane,

A quick note to let you know that Esquimalt Nation does not have any further comments regarding the Joint Guidelines and Plans.

Their comments are as reflected in their January 7, 2022 letter, attached for ease of reference.

They acknowledge the positive step Canada has taken, proposing to extend the scope of marine shipping from 12nm to 67nm along the route that proceeds west from Barkley Sound. However, they continue to support scoping that captures the entire route within Canadian jurisdiction (i.e. to 200nm and capturing traffic proceeding northward along the Coast).
