I am also concerned how the project will affect traditional land use.

As I am sure you are aware, Indigenous people are very connected to the land. We use it for medicine picking, hunting, fishing, ceremony, and various other activities. We are Treaty Six signatories and as such have every right to harvest and use the land. We are always careful to give back to our mother earth.

My recommendation is a full-scale reclamation of the land being utilized. I have been to other sites where the original inhabitants of the land have been reclaimed as the project moves along. That being the trees, grass, traditional medicines and whatever else has been displaced during the construction phase, so that the environment and wildlife can once again flourish.
