RE: Municipality of Kincardine comments on the Bruce C draft Cooperation Plan

To Whom it May Concern:

Please accept the comments below from the Municipality of Kincardine on the [draft Cooperation Plan](#) for the Bruce C Nuclear Project. This submission was endorsed by the Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of Kincardine at the July 9, 2025, meeting.

The Municipality of Kincardine is the host Municipality to Bruce Power, Ontario Power Generation's Western Waste Management Facility and the Douglas Point Nuclear Generating Station. Combined, our Municipality is host to one of the world's largest nuclear facilities.

The Municipality's expectation is that there will be a multi-ministerial roundtable being led by the Ministry of Energy and Mines for this significant energy infrastructure project. We are hopeful that additional Ontario Provincial Ministries will be participating in the Integrated Assessment as listed in Appendix 1 of the draft Cooperation Plan. Currently there is only one Ministry participating as is identified in Appendix 1, which is disappointing as the issues associated with impacts are expected to include a variety of Ministries and the local impact of not addressing this will be felt acutely by the host community.

Energy and specifically nuclear, are a high priority for the current Provincial government as is outlined in the newly released [Energy for Generations Ontario's Integrated Plan to Power the Strongest Economy in the G7](#). The Municipality of Kincardine is encouraged by the bold and cooperative action being taken but the Province in this new energy plan and appreciate the acknowledgement of the Bruce C project throughout the plan. As such, we question why more Provincial Ministries are not participating in the integrated assessment process for the Bruce C Project.

The Municipality recognized that [IAAC sent letters to the various provincial ministries](#) earlier this year and are inviting input from additional provincial ministries with potential EA, permitting or approval requirements related to the Project. We look forward to seeing more provincial involvement in the final Cooperation Plan.
