Comment on the Draft Integrated Tailored Impact Statement Guidelines for the Bruce C Nuclear Project.

Last year we submitted a letter (Oct. 28, 2024) to this IAAC process for the Bruce C Nuclear Project outlining our reasons for insisting that alternatives to the proposed project be considered in the Guidelines document for the Impact Assessment.

We are dismayed to see that alternatives to the proposed project are not included in the draft Guidelines document and urge you to include this requirement in the final document.

In our earlier letter, we alerted you to an upcoming report on Indigenous perspectives on radioactive waste. We co-published that report November 2024; it is available for download here: <https://cedar-project.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/11/2024-Indigenous-views-on-nuclear-energy-and-waste.pdf>

We are also dismayed to see that, contrary to the expressed desires of many Indigenous nations, the long-term management of radioactive waste may be excluded from the Guidelines. We urge you to reconsider and require the proponent to address long-term waste management.
