To Whom It may Concern

Our group was disappointed with the very short comment period. With several storms during these 30 days, we were impacted by loss of power and Internet services.

We believe that the risks from transportation should definitely be included in the Impact Assessment process. Those along the travel route will be impacted by the 2-3 trucks per day. With transportation of the waste inventory requiring about 50 years, the general public needs to have the opportunity to comment on both current risks and those anticipated in 20 to 50 years time. We firmly believe the public has a right to evaluate the potential for accidents that could well result in exposure to radiation.

We strongly recommend inclusion of Transportation in the Federal Impact Assessment Process.
