I have some concerns that for years it was always said transportation would be included in the impact assessment and the Nuclear Waste Management Organization removed this in their project description. So now only the local communities of Ignace and Wabigoon Lake First Nation closest to the proposed site get to have a full say, rather than all the communities along the proposed shipping route. It's really outrageous and I think the most serious proposal we've ever had in Canada; way beyond issues related to mining, tar sands, pipelines etc. The waste needs to be managed essentially forever (millions of years) and the risk of accidents with transportation across the province is high on our already dangerous highways, increasing the risk of potential spills. I don't believe we can trust the claims that they will create shipping containers that are totally safe; this has never been done before to my knowledge. I live right next to the highway in Thunder Bay, and think having the transportation portion as part of the impact assessment would go a long way to easing concerns about this project.
