To whom it may concern.

I'm writing to tell you that I am completely against the plan to build a nuclear waste dump near Ignace. I live and work in Northwestern Ontario, and I think this is a bad idea that puts our home at risk.

My biggest worry is that it will poison our land and water forever. We have clean lakes and rivers here. One accident or leak over the hundreds of years this waste will be dangerous could ruin that for everyone who comes after us. We shouldn't have to carry that risk.

I also don't think our area can handle it. We already don't have enough hospitals or doctors out here. Our highways are bad—they're narrow, not built for heavy traffic, and scary to drive in the winter. Bringing nuclear waste through here on those roads for years sounds like a disaster waiting to happen.

A lot of people I talk to don't want this. It feels like our part of the province is being picked because they think we won't fight back. We're not a wasteland. We're a community.

Please listen to us. This project doesn't make our communities stronger or safer. We need better healthcare and better roads, not a permanent nuclear waste site that most of us don't want.
