I have many concerns about the process and decisions regarding this project.

The decision on selecting Ignace is obviously primarily about the potential willingness of the area to accept such waste not whether it makes sense to ship nuclear waste such a distance.

The decision to separate out from the approval of nuclear waste disposal site from the transportation of the waste from existing nuclear power sites makes no sense in my view.

That for 160 years the project expects to ship nuclear waste all the way to Ignace from the nuclear power plants east of Toronto is absurd.

The mandate should be keeping the waste as close as possible to the sites where it is produced.
