I am writing to assert my bloodline lineage in protection of Traditional lands & waterways in the Hieght of Land Territory.

I strongly oppose the destruction of our waters ways & traditional lands as the Nuclear Waste Management Organization has not given free and prior informed consent to the Traditional Title Rights holders of our Nation & therefore is in direct violation of Nation to Nation Treaty Agreements to preserve ALL LIFE as Long As the Grass Grows, As Long As the Rivets Flow & As long as the Sun Shall Shine.

Under International Laws Title & Rights holders as Sovereigns have the Maritime Authority to oppose such a disastrous death deal that invades & tramples on the Rights of the Anishnawbe Nation.

I give 100% opposition to this deal.

As a Ogichidaa Ikwe Warrior Woman of my Nation it is my duty to uphold the Original Laws of Creation & preservation of Life not just for human beings but for the Flora & Fauna Life & Aquatic Life in the North Western Ontario Territory.

Therefore I express my ceace & desist of this DGR PLAN in Ignace that will ultimately affect the lives of future generations.

You have been served your Notice as a Member of the Anishnawbe Nation.
