Good day,

My name is Angel Gamble and am an Indigenous Engineer Technologist - Intermediate. I have worked in Oil & Gas for 10 years and the last here in Northwest Ontario for the last 5 years. My hometown is Thunder Bay and am a Nomadic First Nation from the Willow Cree Tribe. I have a tribal interest in this project and have some serious concerns of its process, development, transport, training, monitoring and existence in the location chosen.

1. Transportation - training required and experience needed 10+ years of safe driving with zero accidents.
2. Spill or accident of nuclear cells in transport of said items to be stored.
3. Containment which we do not have any such building practices that will allow the safe storage of the time life of spent cells.
4. Indigenous engagement of these routes and how it will impact the ground water as its a radiation item in the ground. What is its nature of plume in ground soil and water which moves like veins around the said chosen site.
5. Who is the governing body of these sites and who is to be contacted.
6. Removal of said cells should it be found to be detrimental to humans and wildlife. What is the action plan and relocation plan of spent nuclear cells.
7. Habitat assessment of plants and animals migration and breeding ground around this site. Has this been done to date or not.
8. Monitoring equipment as these items have a thousands of lifetimes of cell life of radiation who is to monitor and how far is the monitoring equipment going to be placed. Will this be accessible to all people online.
9. Emergency evacuation plan for surrounding people and their homes should a leak happen as this is life ending to all by way of radiation leakage and cellular damaging/changing on everything living.
10. Who is paying for all these systems that will need to be in place not just transport, but Evacuation, emergency training, monitoring, online access of monitors, people in charge, government departments responsible for any type of emergency or need. Response time will need to be immediate.

I am an Indigenous Engineer and gather in this area as well as hunt so I have an established plus invested interest in all this process now that I have thought of it for some time.
