**Re: Comments of Louis Bull Tribe (“LBT”) in response to the recent designation request for Vista Phase II Expansion Project (the “Project”)**

I write in my capacity as Consultation Director of Louis Bull Tribe.

I am aware of requests to the Minister that the Project be designated for review under the Impact Assessment Act, SC 2019, c 28, s 1 (the “Act”). As the Minister should be aware, in May 2020 LBT also made a request that the Project be designated for review under the Act. We note that the recent requests for designation make reference to LBT’s concerns about the Project’s potential impacts to the rights of LBT and its citizens. It is important to note that, since the time of LBT’s designation request in 2020, LBT has concluded a Relationship Agreement with Coalspur through which Coalspur and LBT have worked productively to address concerns about impacts to LBT’s rights.
